Classes may be added or scratched 2 classes prior.

Three minute tack changes are allowed if necessary, (and will be strictly adhered to) the ring steward must be notified in advance.

No Trail entries or paid scratches will be accepted after the start of class #68

***All Equitation, Pleasure and Games Class will be on the FLAT.**

* For classes 57& 58, 59 & 60, 63 & 64, 67 & 68 may be run together, but pinned separately if less than 3 entries in each age division. (Show management will decide, and make proper announcement.)

*Classes 1, 2, 5-9, 11, 12, 14, 16, 17, 21-24, 26, 31-33, 37, 41-43, 45-49, 53-62, 64-74, are open to BOTH horse and pony.

*Classes may be added and/or scratched up to two classes before the class to be added/scratched. Once trail classes begin, no more entries or paid scratches will be accepted for any trail class.

All youth Walk Trot and Leadline exhibitors (English AND Western exhibitors) shall be required to wear protective headgear whenever mounted on the Silver Heels show grounds. Helmets passing or surpassing ASTM/SEI standards are recommended.

All Handlers for the Leadline Division or Walk Trot/Novice Walk Trot Egg & Spoon classes shall be 14 years or older.

Green Horse/Pony Walk Trot Class, Green Horse/Pony Walk Trot Canter Class and 2 & 3 year old Pleasure class are NOT ELIEGIBLE for year end awards!
